

## UPDATE - upcoming investigation works in your area

### **Elizabeth Street Sewer Upgrade Project**

To cater for growth in Melbourne's CBD, Greater Western Water is finalising the design for a new sewer in Elizabeth Street between Lonsdale and Victoria streets.

The project will be delivered for Greater Western Water by Rob Carr Pty Ltd and their design consultant SMEC, with construction to begin from mid-2022 and completed in early 2023. More information about construction of the sewer will be provided ahead of works commencing.

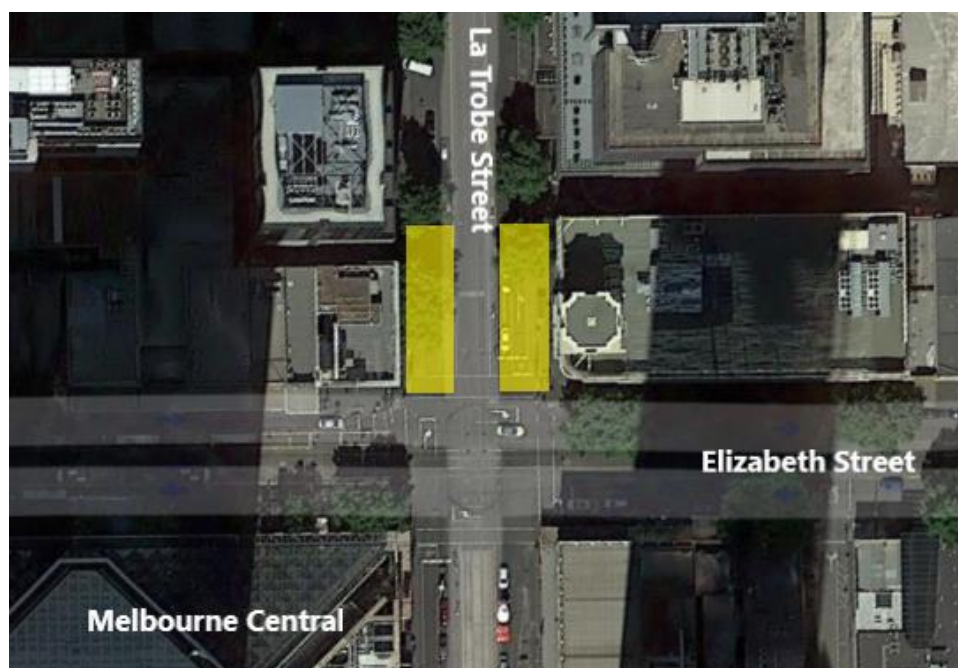
### **What we are doing and when**

As part of the design work, investigation works are required to be undertaken, including confirming the location of underground assets beneath La Trobe Street. These works will occur west of the intersection of Elizabeth and La Trobe streets within the two areas shown in yellow on the map below.

Work is scheduled to occur between mid-May and mid-June 2022 and is expected to take around five nights in each location.

### **Works are now planned to be undertaken during the following times:**

- 7.30am to 7pm, Saturday and Sunday
- 6.30pm to 2.30am, Monday to Wednesday nights.





## What to expect

While we will continue to make every effort to minimise disruption and inconvenience to you, the following can be expected:

- Scanning equipment, saw cutting, a non-destructive digging (NDD) truck, excavator and tipper truck will be used to locate the underground assets. Saw cutting and NDD may involve brief periods of louder noise, and will be completed before midnight
- This work will not impact your sewerage or water supplies.

## Traffic impacts

- La Trobe street will be closed to through traffic just west of Elizabeth Street for around five nights, one side of the road at a time. Local access to car parks and driveways will be maintained under traffic control during work
- During work hours, there will be brief holds of traffic at the intersection of La Trobe and Elizabeth streets while construction vehicles enter and exit the site
- The outer eastbound lane on La Trobe Street west of Elizabeth Street may remain closed during the day. Traffic will be maintained via the inner eastbound lane
- Traffic management and local detours will be in place to ensure pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles are able to move safely around the area. Parking spaces adjacent to the work area may be occupied during work hours
- This work will not impact tram services.

## Why are we doing these works at night?

In this location, night works are required to minimise traffic delays and impacts to tram services and local businesses.
