

## REMINDER: Upcoming works in your area

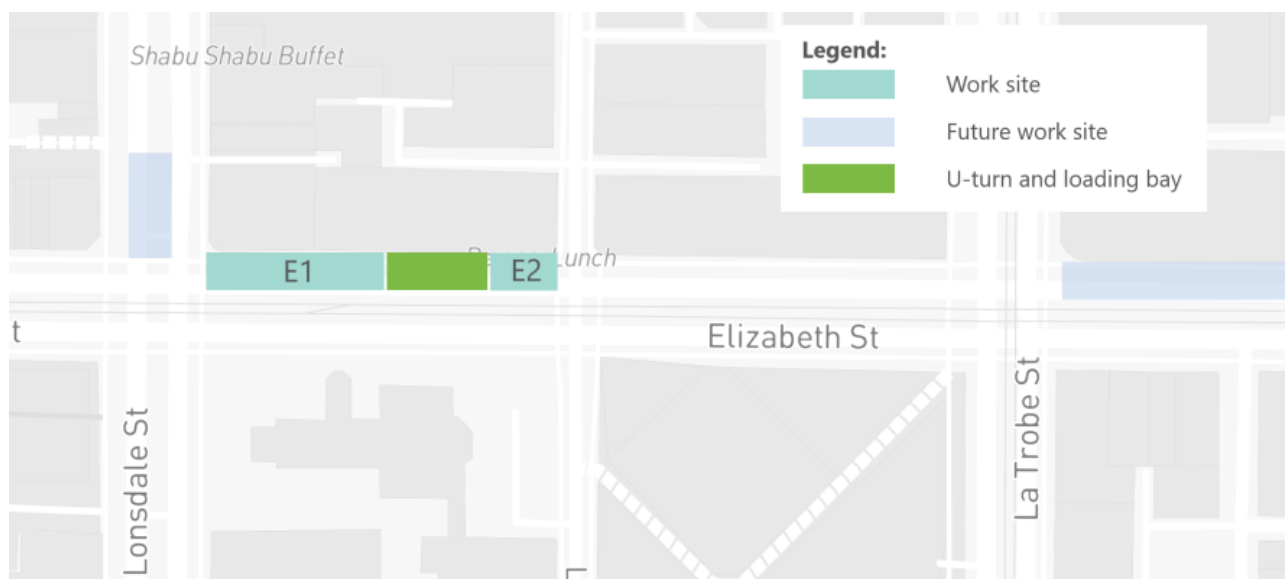
### Elizabeth Street Sewer Upgrade Project

To cater for growth in Melbourne's CBD, Greater Western Water is constructing a new sewer in Elizabeth Street between Lonsdale and Victoria streets. The project will be delivered for Greater Western Water by Rob Carr Pty Ltd.

Further to the notification dated 16 December 2022, works will soon begin at sites E1 and E2 (see map below) on Elizabeth Street, between Lonsdale and Little Lonsdale streets. Further information will be provided to nearby properties before we start works at other sites.

#### What we are doing and when

The first stages of work at sites E1 and E2 involve site establishment and excavation of temporary shafts, including some night works.



#### Site E1

- Site establishment will begin on Monday 20 February 2023. This will involve up to four night shifts (from after the last scheduled tram service until 5am) and day works to install barriers, fencing and signage.
- From Monday 28 February to Thursday 2 March there will be night works to start excavation next to tram lines between 9pm and 5am. There will be changes to tram services during this time.
- Outside of these times, works will occur between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am and 1pm Saturdays.



## Site E2

- Site establishment will begin on Tuesday 14 March 2023. This will take three nights (from 9pm until 5am) to install barriers, fencing and signage, and start excavation next to tram lines. There will be changes to tram services during this time.
- Following these night shifts, work will occur between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am and 1pm Saturdays.

Once these works are complete, tunnelling can commence. Further updates will be provided before tunnelling begins.

## Traffic impacts

- The northbound lanes on Elizabeth Street (including on-street parking) will be closed between Lonsdale and Little Lonsdale streets from 20 February 2023.
- Footpaths and pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
- There will be a temporary loading bay for delivery vehicles, bin collection and emergency services to access businesses on the west side of Elizabeth Street in the location shown on the map. This can be accessed via U-turn from the southbound lanes on Elizabeth Street, assisted by traffic controllers.

## Why are we doing these works at night?

Some activities need to be completed at night to minimise traffic delays and impacts to tram services and local businesses.

Sound mitigating barriers and screens will be placed around generators and other equipment where possible to minimise noise during night works.
