Greater Western Water: upcoming works in your area

Sunbury area is experiencing significant population growth, and Greater Western Water needs to increase the capacity of our infrastructure to meet local needs.

To help us meet demand, we are installing a duplicate sewer, which is a new sewer pipeline that runs along an existing sewer line.

What are we doing?

We are installing a new sewer pipeline around 1km long along the existing sewer alignment shown in Figure 1 below.

- Northern section: about 400m in length
- Southern section: about 600m in length

This duplicate pipeline will help increase the sewer capacity to meet growing demand.

When will works happen?

The construction for the southern section of the sewer is anticipated to start in early October 2022. Some minor works including site establishment, delivery of materials and site preparation, will start soon in the area outlined in blue in Figure 1.

We will keep you updated as the works on the southern section progress.

We expect construction for the northern section of the sewer to start in late November 2022, with construction complete in April 2023. We'll be in touch with residents in the area before these works begin.

What does this mean for you?

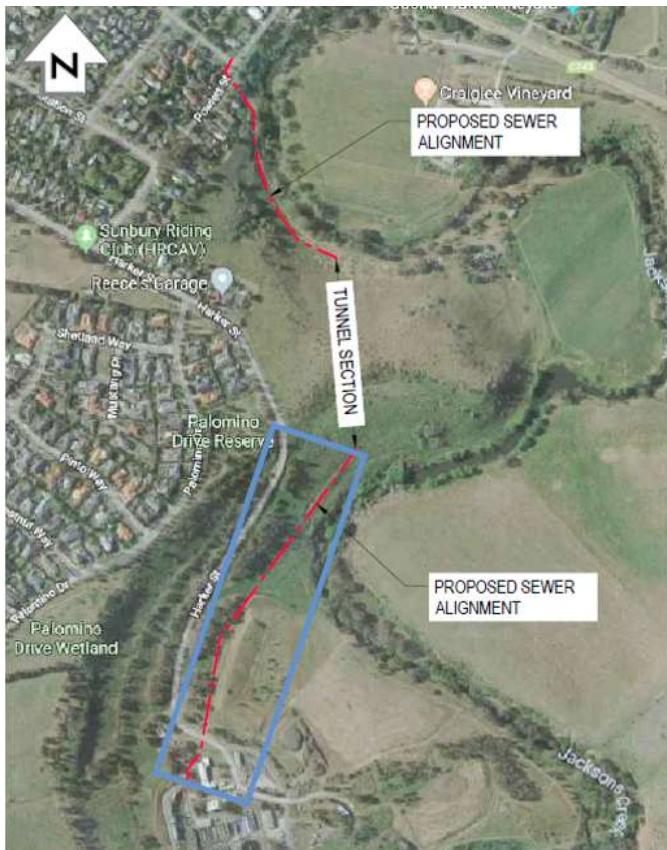
Residents on Harker Street may see some truck movements for deliveries of equipment and construction materials during working hours.

Works will be carried out from October 2022 to May 2023 (estimated).
