

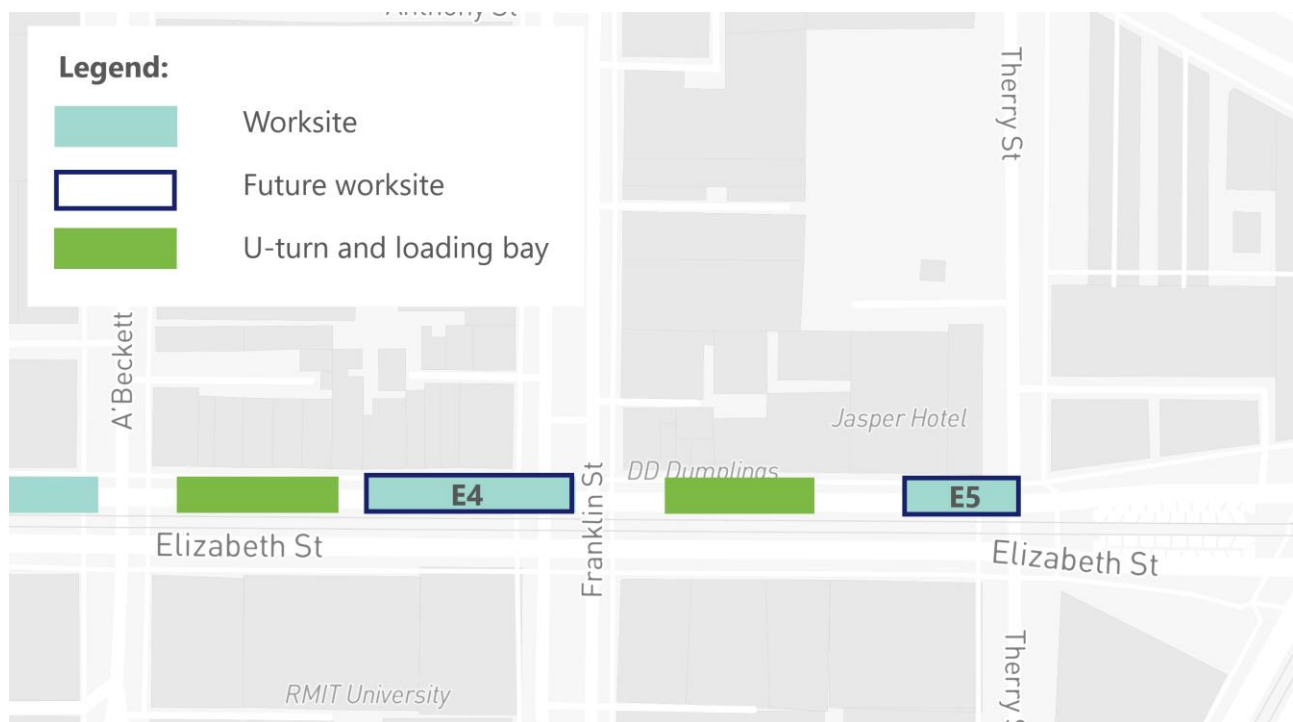
Upcoming works: Elizabeth Street between Franklin Street and Therry Street

3 July 2023

Elizabeth Street Sewer Upgrade Project

To cater for growth in Melbourne's CBD, Greater Western Water is constructing a new sewer in Elizabeth Street between Lonsdale and Victoria streets. The project will be delivered for Greater Western Water by Rob Carr Pty Ltd.

Work is now underway on Lonsdale Street and on Elizabeth Street between Lonsdale and A'Beckett streets. In July, we will establish two more worksites in the northbound lanes on Elizabeth Street, at Franklin Street (site E4) and Therry Street (E5) – see map below.



Elizabeth Street near Therry Street – site E5

- Site E5 will be established on Monday 17 July 2023.
- There will be night works from Monday 17 July to Thursday 20 July (9pm to 5am) to commence excavation adjacent to the tram line. There will be changes to tram services during these times.
- From Thursday 20 July, works will occur between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm Saturdays.
- Initial works involve shaft construction and then tunnelling. More information about these activities can be found at: yoursay.gww.com.au/elizabeth-st

Elizabeth Street near Franklin Street – site E4

- In early June, works to commence excavation adjacent to the tram line were completed, and the road was reopened.
- Site establishment is scheduled to occur in mid to late July. Further advice will be provided to adjacent properties before works start.

Traffic impacts

- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist vehicles and pedestrians.
- The northbound lanes on Elizabeth Street will be closed between Lonsdale and Therry streets.
- Local access will be maintained between A'Beckett Street and the E4 worksite, and Franklin Street and the E5 worksite for deliveries, waste collection and emergency services.
- Some parking conditions on side streets will be changed to provide temporary loading, car share and disability parking spaces. 6 motorcycle parking spaces on Franklin Street will be closed during works.
- Footpaths and access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

What to expect

- The layout and equipment needed on site will change with each phase of construction. At sites E4 and E5, there will be a storage shed, small site facilities and excavation machinery during site establishment and shaft construction.
- Tunnelling requires several shipping-style containers that will be moved between sites as tunnelling progresses. This equipment will be based at each site for around 3 to 6 weeks.
- Barriers, fencing and signage will be in place during all construction phases.
- This work will not affect your sewerage or water supplies.
